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2020 SKILLS ASSESSMENT INFORMATION SHEET

LITTLE LEAGUE (ALL PLAYERS AGE 8-12)

Times & Dates

At this time we would like to welcome our players and parents to the 2020 baseball season. Your child will participate in a Skills Assessment (for team placement) on Saturday, February 1. The Skills Assessment site is Lucchesi Park Turf Field. (This is an all-artificial turf field so please wear athletic or turf shoes only.) We realize that many of the players may have youth basketball games that day. The times indicated below are the ones selected for your child's age group. If this particular time is difficult, your child may try-out at any of the other posted times that day. All prospective players MUST participate in the Skills Assessment. Here is the skills assessment schedule:

Please plan for your child to attend one of the time periods. Players should arrive 30 minutes before their scheduled time to check-in and warm-up. If it is impossible for your child to participate on this day, please contact one of the directors listed below as soon as possible.

What Happens at Tryouts?

After checking in and warming up, the players will run through a series of three drills. These drills will test their coordination and ability to: 1.) catch grounders and make short throws, 2.) catch flies and make longer throws, and 3.) swing a bat. It is a good idea to wear comfortable clothes that will allow the child to perform.

The following table gives you an overview of which level your child is trying-out for:

<u>Note</u>: All Returning Major Division Players and all 12 year-olds <u>MUST</u> be drafted to Major Division teams.

<u>Note</u>: 9-12 year-olds <u>must</u> participate in assessments. 8 year-olds <u>may</u> try-out for 8-11 Minor if they wish. 8 year-olds that do try-out but are not selected to an 8-11 Minor team will play in the 6-8 Minor Division. 6 and 7 year-olds do not try-out and are placed on 6-8 Minor-Machine Pitch team (or T-Ball team) by the League.

When Will We Be Notified?

The Major Division draft is held on the Monday or Tuesday following the assessments and the 8-11 Minor Division draft is held a few days later. You should be notified soon after these draft meetings. If you have not been notified after one full week, please call one of the directors listed below. We hope the 2020 baseball season will be a rewarding one for your child.

NOTE: If it is raining, **please check anyway**. Light rain or intermittent showers will not stop assessments. If it is raining heavily, our rain date will be Sunday, February 2; same times.

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2020 Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

All adults associated with the PVLL shall bear in mind that the attainment of exceptional athletic skill or the winning of games is secondary, and the molding of future citizens is of prime importance.

We all have our own set of responsibilities and expectations that we must make every effort to meet or exceed. The following are the PVLL's expectations of ALL parents/guardians:

- Attend my child's games.
- Be supportive of the manager, coaches and all members of my child's team.
- Communicate with managers, coaches and other adult volunteers in appropriate ways.
- Cheer for all players of the team and make only positive comments.
- Be a positive role model exhibiting only good sportsmanship.
- Attend games whether or not my child is completely successful.
- Show respect and support toward umpires and other volunteers.
- Understand that the game of baseball is difficult to learn and play.
- Look for opportunities to work with and encourage my child.
- Be positive and supportive whether the team wins or loses.
- Teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.

I understand and accept the PVLL's expectations of parents/guardians. If I violate this code, I may be asked to leave the game and the ballpark. I also understand that continued violation of the code may result in my being banned from further attendance at games for the remainder of the Little League season.
